CSI CHAPTER BEST PRACTICES TO GROW THE NORTHWEST MEMBERSHIP

Maintaining membership was the theme of last month's article, which identified ways to retain our membership through a number of Tips that can be found in the Institute's Chapter Best Practices guide, as presented by the Institute Membership Committee. This CSI Chapter Best Practices guide can be found and downloaded from the CSI web site www.csinet.org.

Every year, chapter leaders evaluate their chapter's overall plan and performance and ask themselves: How can we increase our membership participations in chapter functions? What do chapter leaders need to do to increase interest in the programs?

Good leaders evaluate the course the chapter is taking to make the membership more active with programs and educational seminars, as well as providing informational and interesting meetings to help create a balance in the membership of professional and industry members.

CSI Chapter Best Practices

CSI Best Practices addresses a number of ideas for the chapter leaders such as:

- Meeting Location: Choose the best place that would make the most members want to attend.
- Meeting Time: Choose the time to hold your meeting that is easiest to make for the majority.
- Meeting Notice: Long lead time, bring up immediately available multiple information sources, and "build the meeting interest for the membership."
- Meeting Reservations: Have standing reservations at the beginning of the year for ease of Response.
- Meal pricing program: Several great ideas were listed.
- Meeting Hospitality and Conduct.
- Programs and Program Topics. (Hot topics drive interest, advanced notification instills a desire to attend).
- Program Speakers & Tips for having successful programs.

CSI Best Practices should be in every chapter leaders' meeting folder and reviewed monthly, prior to board meetings, as a guide for chapter success.

Let us all continue the excellent effort in increasing and maintaining our Northwest Chapters' membership and CSI interest.

BIG SKY CHAPTER BECOMES A REGISTERED CSI CEN PROVIDER

Big Sky Chapter members now have another incentive to attend chapter meetings . . . continuing education credits!

On September 24, 2007, the Big Sky Chapter received a letter of approval from Jeff Iwankow, Chief Operations Executive for CSI's Construction Education Network, indicating that our application had been approved. The CSI CEN program sets the industry standards for continuing education programs, based on International Association for Continuing Education and Training (IACET) criteria. CSI CEU's and HSW continuing education credits are accepted by licensing, certification, and accreditation agencies.



The Big Sky Chapter joins the following CSI Chapters currently listed as having become a CEN provider: Palm Beach Chapter, Capital Chapter (125), Baltimore Chapter, Milwaukee Chapter, Housatonic Chapter (110), Central Virginia Chapter, Pensacola Chapter, Los Angeles Chapter, Mt.
